Shaun MacGillivray is Producer and President of MacGillivray Freeman Films, the world's foremost independent producer and distributor of films made for IMAX® and other giant-screen theatres. The company has 40 films for IMAX® theatres to its credit. Throughout the company's 50-year history, its films have won numerous international awards including two Academy Award® nominations and three films inducted into the IMAX Hall of Fame. The son of award-winning filmmaker Greg MacGillivray, Shaun grew up on film locations all around the world.

Producer of the award-winning 3D giant-screen films *National Parks Adventure*, *Humpback Whales*, *Journey To The South Pacific*, *To The Arctic* and *Grand Canyon Adventure*, MacGillivray is also the producer of the upcoming film *Dream Big: Engineering Our World*, which will be released on February 17, 2017. Shaun is also Managing Director of the company's One World One Ocean Campaign, a multi-year, multi-platform ocean media initiative aimed at inspiring greater public awareness about the world's oceans.

Shaun graduated Magna Cum Laude from Emory University with a degree in economics, then went on to receive a graduate MFA degree in Film Production from the University of Southern California. Shaun and his wife Katie and three children live in Laguna Beach.
